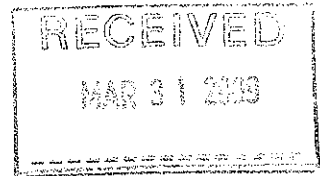


Please accept this as written notice to your council that we now have full authority over the village of Kisgega'as. All projects on our village are now under our authority. Please turn over to us all relevant information such as documents, financial records and project funding. All persons that are not descendants of our huwilp must have written permission to enter our village.

As a courtesy, we the undersigned owners of Kisgega'as village provided you with written notice dated January 30, 2009 that the Gitanmaax Band Council relinquish *illegal authority* over our village by February 27, 2009. However, since that date your conduct has been only to avoid the issue.


On February 27, 2009 you said your council will take our information under advisement. On March 13, 2009 you stated that you would review information in the archives before providing your position on our request. On March 23, 2009 you provided written notice that the Gitanmaax Band Council will not engage in any further meetings with the chiefs of Kisgega'as. As a result, we understand that your council will not contradict our authority and is now stepping aside.


By stepping aside you have corrected what was illegally done 50 years ago. We were prohibited by law to protest when our village was transferred to the authority of the Gitanmaax Band Council in 1948. At that time, it was unlawful for "Indians" to gather in a meeting, to host a feast, and or to have a lawyer to act for us. If we tried to do anything we would have been placed in jail. We are happy that you have decided not to continue this historical wrong committed to us.
